Results

- Audio and video quality were good
 - good conference room microphone.. able to clearly pickup all voices in the room
 - conference room camera that can pan and zoom, though limited.
 - remote participants had difficulty following who in the conference room was speaking.
- USFS does not allow non governmental computers to use office internet. Matt's computer
 will be used for conference room Zoom access.
- Concluded that establishing ground rules for Hybrid meetings would be beneficial.

Additionally, Jeff Randa met with Jim Gruel to understand learnings from his hybrid meeting experience.

Hybrid Meeting Ground Rules

- All meeting participants (conference room and attending remotely) must raise their hand and be recognized prior to speaking.
- Mark and Sean will have primary responsibility for identifying those who raise their hands.
- All conference room attendees should announce their names prior to their comments then speak slower and louder to ensure remote participants can hear clearly.
- •Side conversations should be avoided or very limited.
- If the County Covid level goes to High everyone will be required to wear masks inside the building (current CDC community level is Medium)
