- -Celia Walker and Jeff Randa made and received donations for the raffle. If we do this again, budget more for prizes.
- -The First United Methodist Church welcomed PWV back again. They gave us a substantial discount on their facility rental. Book 4-6 months ahead if using them again.
- -We did not have PWV merchandise for sale, as promised. In the future, confirm that Patrol Gear can attend and will have items for sale.
- -Verbal feedback has been positive; some people saw this as PWV's first social event of the patrolling season. Presenters were very prepared and sessions were well-attended. Special thanks to Janet and Karl for the sing-along!
- -Course Evaluations were done by QR code: only 8 responses. Overall scores 4.9; length was "just right."
- -We have put relevant documents into a Google Drive File, in case the BOD wants to have Spring Tune-Up in 2024. However, Janet Caille and Linda Reiter will NOT be chairing it. We have approached Vickie Taylor and the Supplemental Training Committee as possible successors. We strongly recommend that the current Chair and Chair-elect quickly follow through on these suggestions.

4. **Motion**: that PWV donate \$100 to the First United Methodist Church to thank them for hosting the Spring Tune-Up. (note: they only charged us \$60 for rental, including set up, clean up, and walkthroughs; when the Board approved the budget increase from \$300 to \$600, it was suggested that unspent funds be given to the church as a donation; the FUMC staff welcomed PWV and offered to host us again.)
